STEP 2: BECOME A MEMBER

STEP 3: START AS A PRODUCTION ASSISTANT

Your first opportunity to get involved will be as a Production Assistant (PA) for NUTV's show *Full Frontal*. Other opportunities for participation include reoccurring roles in webisode production, representing NUTV at events on campus, assisting with administrative tasks and social media.

STEP 4: GET TRAINING

Once you have completed two credits as a Production Assistant (PA), you are invited to learn the basics of television production from our professional staff.

Training sessions and workshops will teach you:

- Camera operation, sound recording & lighting
- Live studio production
- Editing with Final Cut Pro
- Research, writing & reporting/hosting

STEP 5: JOIN THE NUTV CREW

Crew members produce engaging, high-quality, content. To become a crew member you are required to complete one or more components of basic training OR contribute to NUTV productions.

STEP 6: HAVE FUN!

In addition to making killer content we also offer plenty of opportunities to make new friends with a variety of social activities and skill development workshops for NUTV members.

OVERVIEW

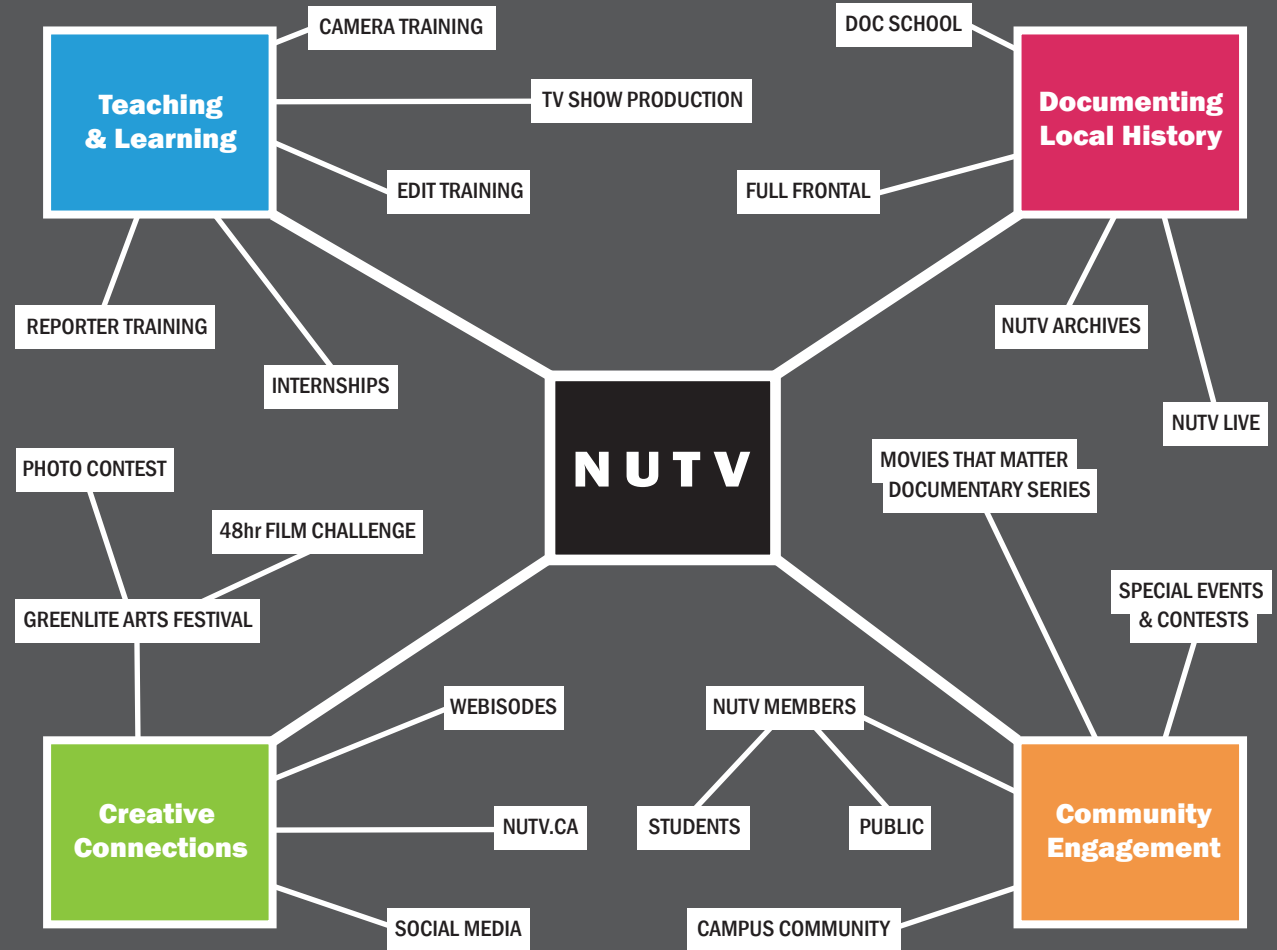
