

Make your first short film with our help at the NUTV Summer Film School!

NUTV Summer Film School provides beginner filmmakers with a crash course in all the skills you need to bring a story to life on camera. Every Thursday, Friday and Saturday from May-August, 2019, Summer Film School students take workshops taught by local industry professionals and work together to create six short films. Summer Film School workshops offer students the chance to learn a variety of filmmaking skills, which they will later apply on their own sets, as well as on the other students' productions.

Students not only get to hone their skills by writing and directing their own film, they also rotate through the roles of Writer/Director, Producer, Camera, Sound, Assistant Director and Art Director.on other students sets. This teamwork builds a crew of young filmmakers that have an array of skills and can work together. Students will take part in the following advanced workshops taught by film industry professionals:

Screenwriting
Producing and Directing
Art Direction & Assistant Directing
Camera
Sound
Casting/Working with Actors
Editing

All Summer Film School films will be screened at the end of the summer in the **NUTV Student Film Festival**. This festival seeks to encourage young filmmakers from around Alberta by promoting their talent and highlighting Alberta's best student films. This includes the short films created by students during the NUTV Summer Film School program.



Guidelines

Please be detailed and concise in your application! NUTV Summer Film School only accepts SIX applicants per summer. All selected candidates will be expected to have strong teamwork skillsand the ability to collaborate creatively and effectively with others, as all students will be switching roles on each other's projects. NUTV is a creative safe space so negative behavior will not be tolerated. All short films can only be a maximum of 6 minutes long. If accepted, you will be working against time constraints throughout the program, especially if you are working full-time, or have any academic course load over the spring/summer sessions. Think of Summer Film School as being registered in a challenging university course over the spring/summer months. Workshop times will be decided based on student's availability. Everyone will swap roles on each productions. The six alternating roles are: Writer/Director, Producer, Camera, Sound, Assistant Director and Art Director.

- 1. To the best of my knowledge, the information in this application is true.
- 2. I will take full responsibility for my conduct on any NUTV production while on the premises of NUTV, or outside, as noted in The New University Television Society by-laws.
- 3. All principle crew members must be NUTV members/volunteers or members of the Summer Film School
- 4. The members of the Summer Film School will report directly to the Program Director and the Executive Director
- 5. Final runtime of piece: maximum 6 minutes (with credits, no exceptions).
- 6. The Producer/Program Director reserves the right to halt the production if any NUTV policies are breached.
- 7. NUTV assumes full ownership copyright, including broadcast rights, and the right to first broadcast/premiere. NUTV head credit: "NUTV Presents" must be over picture at start of documentary. End credit: © NUTV 2019 w/ NUTV logo
- 8. The production must adhere to all NUTV policies and procedures.
- 9. All workshops must be completed in order for Summer Film School Students to work on projects
- 10. Equipment must be booked properly in the online system, and bookings must respect the priority of other NUTV programming.
- 11. All projects must be edited at NUTV, using NUTV edit suites.
- 12. All music used in the program must be royalty free or have written permission by the music artist, publisher, and any performers. This is the responsibility of theapplicant, not NUTV.
- 13. The project will be completed before the end of September 11, 2019.
- **14.** Film School participants must be available for workshops and productions every Thursday, Friday and Saturday from May-August, 2019
- 15. The applicant understands that participants for Film School will be selected on a competitive basis as per the contents of this application, the status of the applying member(s) and their contributions to NUTV.
- 16. NUTV reserves the right to cancel the program if there are not enough suitable applicants
